- (a) i. The process can be streamlined using an Input Mask for the NIC Number Field. The filed should only allow 10 character input, while the Input Mask should allow the first 9 characters to be digits followed by the letter V.

Go the validation rule property

Go the expression builder and type/ create the following expression

Most of the time the difference is on the URL, in which a letter or two gets shuffled and this will not get notified to the user. User will enter the sensitive data to the phishing site without knowing that is a fake website. The hacker who creates the site will steal the information entered and use them to access the bank's internet banking portal.
